Frederic Schöning is educated in solo piano playing at the Academies of Music in Gothenburg and Malmö by Professor Hans Palsson and has been taught by pianists such as Per Tengstrand, Roland Pontinen, Simon Crawford-Phillips, Juhani Lagerspetz (FIN) and Tamas Ungar (USA). Frederic teaches diligently and has a large number of students in and outside Lund where he has been living for the last few years. The music of W.A. Mozart is special to him, and in recent years he has chosen to specialize in Mozart's piano repertoire.

Rose-Marie Nord is a classic violinist who also has the compositions of Wolfgang Amadeus as her favorite music. She is active as a chamber musician in different contexts, both as violinist and violist. After studying in Arvika under Professor Magnus Ericsson, in Gothenburg under Marja Inkinen and in Malmö under Professor Marika Faltskog, she is now living in Gothenburg. Rose-Marie combines her own musicianship with teaching. She has performed as a violin soloist with various orchestras, including Östersund Orkesterforening and the String Orchestra Camerata Gothia.
